

Chassagne-Montrachet  
1er Cru Morgeot “Les Fairendes”



#### Origin

The plot is located in the Premier Cru Morgeot appellation, in the lieu-dit Les Fairendes, to the south of the village of Chassagne-Montrachet, at the bottom of the slope, before reaching Santenay.



#### Soil

The soil is limestone-dominant with more marl than clay. Deep red soils at the bottom of the slope, transitioning to clayey and fine soils at the top. Southeast exposure.



#### Age of Vines

Between 35 and 94 years



#### Tasting Notes

The wines are opulent, rich, creamy, and buttery. They strike a balance between power and finesse, with excellent aging potential. They exhibit finesse and precision.
